Good afternoon,

I sent out an email just before practice last night noting a change to the practice schedule this week to allow people to attend the varsity/jv triangular tonight at Riggs. Below are four announcements that provide corrected information related to the duals and practices that I did not have last night when I sent out my initial email.

Governor Triangular

The Varsity and JV will wrestle simultaneously on two mats this evening against Yankton and Chamberlain. The Yankton dual will get started at 5:00 p.m. this evening at Riggs high school so those interested in attending will want to get there at 5:00 as the dual will kick off with both the JV and Varsity 106lb's wrestling right away. Chamberlain will then wrestle Yankton, and then Pierre will wrestle Chamberlain afterwards with an anticipated start time of 8:00 p.m..

Tuesday Group 1 and 2 Practices Rescheduled

I spoke with Caleb at the conclusion of group 1 practice last night and he is willing to reschedule tonight's cancelled practice for this Thursday (January 5th) at the regularly scheduled time.
